



## Intersection Example

A queue jump lane is an additional bus only transit lane at the intersection which allows buses to bypass the queue. This treatment could be paired with signal priority to allow the buses to get a head start over other vehicles and an easier merge with traffic beyond the intersection. The design of the queue jump is such that through buses share the right-turn lane with cars, but can stop at a red light in such a way as to still allow cars to make a right turn.
