

## CLASS III ARCHAEOLOGICAL RESOURCE INVENTORY OF THE 6TH AVENUE PARKWAY EXTENSION IN AURORA, ARAPAHOE COUNTY, COLORADO

Alpine Archaeological Consultants, Inc. (Alpine) conducted a file search and literature review through the Colorado Office of Archaeology and Historic Preservation in April 2015. In August 2015, Alpine prepared a *Class III Archaeological Resource Inventory of the 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue Parkway Extension in Aurora, Arapahoe County, Colorado* report for review and submittal to CDOT and History Colorado. A total of 11 previous cultural resource surveys had occurred with the project Area of Potential Effect, which resulted in the identification of a historical road and an isolated resource. Alpine also completed an intensive Class III archaeological inventory of the study area in April and August, 2015. During the Class III inventory, Alpine identified no archaeological sites and two isolated resources. All archaeological resources in the study area have been evaluated as not eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) and are not discussed further (**Appendix B** of the EA for the concurrence letter).
