Study Area and Purpose of Study

Study area: El Paso County outside of Colorado Springs Urbanizing Area; west of US 24 study area.

Purpose: Update to 1987 plan. Understand present traffic conditions and future transportation needs for unincorporated El Paso County and to identify major transportation corridors improvements necessary to accommodate these needs.

Key Points of Study

- 1. 6-lane width for US 24 study area shown in Recommended Preserved Corridor Network.
- 2. Potential Colorado Springs Rapid Transit Corridor from I-25 to the Manitou Avenue Interchange.
- 3. Potential Trail in Recommended Bicycle Routes Plan.
- 4. 4-lane expressway for US 24 study area shown in Recommended Major Transportation Corridors for 2005, 2010, 2015, 2020.

Relevance to US24 West project

The plan focuses outside of US 24 study area. It incorporates recommendations from other studies covering the US 24 study area in order to provide connectivity from its plan to the Colorado Springs Urban Area.
