Study Area and Purpose of Study

Study area: Colorado Springs Metropolitan Planning Area, which includes US24 study limits.

Purpose: Identifies the transportation projects in the Colorado Springs Urbanizing Area for which State and or Federal funds will be used along with those of regional significance funded by local or private sources.

Key Points of Study

- 1. The plan is fiscally constrained, so annual project costs do not exceed anticipated revenues.
- 2. US24 is one of the corridors for City-wide congestion management in fiscal years 2005/2006 under the Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality Improvement program.
- 3. Midland Trail Phase II trail construction along US 24 between 21st and 31st Streets is slated for fiscal year 2005 under the Enhancements program.
- 4. Safety/traffic operations improvements, environmental studies, and safety improvements are planned for US 24 between 8th Street and the Manitou Avenue interchange for fiscal years 2007 2010 under the Regional Priorities program.
- 5. North and westbound geometric improvements are planned for the 8th Street intersection in fiscal year 2005 under the Safety program.

Relevance to US24 West project

These improvements will be part of the no-build conditions for the interim and future analysis years.
