US 6C CLIFTON TRANSPORTATION STUDY UNDERWAY

A transportation study of US 6C between I-70B and 33 Road through Clifton is underway. The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) is leading a team to examine alternatives for this important corridor. The study will provide an understanding of the existing and future transportation conditions. The goal of the study is to develop and screen a range of improvements to improve mobility, operations, multimodal facilities, and safety along the US 6C corridor. The study will provide a plan for future short- and long-term transportation improvements.

The first phase of this 12-month study includes gathering public input and evaluation of existing and future conditions. The work will be closely coordinated with local agencies, residents, area businesses and commuters to identify transportation improvements that best meet the study goals while considering existing community plans. The project team will be available to listen to your comments and answer questions at the February 5th public meeting.
