REVIEW OF US 6 CLIFTON TRANSPORTATION STUDY ALTERNATIVES NEEDED

The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) is leading a detailed transportation study of US 6 between I-70B and 33 Road through Clifton. The purpose of the project is to improve existing and future corridor and intersection operations, to enhance multimodal connectivity, and to improve safety for all users. The study will provide a plan for future short- and long-term corridor transportation improvements.

Nearly 20 alternatives were developed and analyzed during this 14-month study. Following three levels of screening, the US 6 Improved Two Through Lanes alternative is being recommended to move forward into further design and project development. The alternatives evaluation completed to date will be presented at the September 29th public meeting. Input from the public meeting will be used to refine the study recommendations before they are finalized.
