US 160 Eastbound/Westbound US 160 Wolf Creek Pass Wolf Creek Pass East Tunnel, east of South Fork (Milemarker 177-178) (through September 2017)

7:00 AM-6:30 PM WE-SA Eastbound lane closed. East and west bound lanes expect brief delays with one-lane alternating traffic day and night for fiber conduit installation. Please follow traffic signal during non working hours and at night. East and westbound shoulder closure throughout project limits. 10 ft width restriction 24/7. **Motorists can expect brief delays with one-lane alternating traffic during the day and night with reduced travel impacts on the weekend.**

Motorists should be aware of flaggers who will guide/control traffic during construction hours as well as a temporary light signals that will control traffic during non-working hours and at night.

There will be east and westbound shoulder closures throughout the project limits. There is a 10 foot width restriction in effect 24/7 until June 15. Motorcyclists are urged to use extreme caution.

US 24 Northbound/Southbound north of Crossman to Mill St., Buena Vista, Chaffee County (Milemarker 209.5-218.5) (through June 2017)

Traffic shifted to outer lanes of US 24. One lane open each direction. The middle lanes are closed US 24 North of Crossman to Mill Street for Construction: new curb, gutter, utility conduits, lighting, pipe and inlet work, storm sewer improvements, paving. **No work Su-Mo, but closures will remain. 12-foot load-width restriction in effect. 24/7 closure on Cottonwood Avenue, just east of US 24 Flaggers will be directing traffic on US 24 between mile points 211 and 213; Project Info Line/Email: 719-398-0819 US24BuenaVista@publicinfo.com.**

US 550 Northbound/Southbound US 550 Northbound/Southbound, Tech Center Dr. to Animas View Dr. (Milemarker 21-24, junction with US 160 north to Animas View Dr.) (Milemarker 21-24) (through June 2017)

24 Hours- SU-SA PROJECT OVERVIEW - US 550 Northbound/Southbound US 550, Mile Marker 21-24 (and a portion of US 160 West). The work zone lies between Tech Center Dr. (on US 160) and Animas View Dr. (on US 550). Work started March 6, completed early June 2017. Work will rehabilitate the concrete surface, protect the concrete panels by clearing and sealing the joints, and construct wheelchair accessible ramps at several key intersections. HOLIDAY WORK SUSPENSION - No work FRIDAY morning at 7 a.m. to TUESDAY morning at 7 a.m.

DAY WORK: TUES-THUR, 7 AM - 7 PM ADA corner curb ramp touch-up work affecting intersections at 31st Street, 30th Street, 29th Street, 26th Street, and 21st Street; all access open but altered temporarily.

NIGHT WORK: TUES - THUR, 6:30 PM - 6:30 AM, Grinding concrete and sawing and sealing concrete panel joints along the full project limits. Grinding/upgrading the surface of the short concrete sections at each side-street approach to US 160/US 550 along the project's length. Inlaid traffic markings will be installed. NOTE - this grinding and saw-cutting work must be done during the night (with a City noise ordinance variance) due to the significant traffic/business impacts it causes during the day, and the amount of time it would take to complete the work under increased summer traffic.

US 550 Northbound/Southbound Molas Pass Molas Pass, Approximately 2 miles south of Silverton, Colorado (Milemarker 68-69) (through October 2017)

24 Hours- SU-SA Northbound lane closures US 550 Approximately 2 miles south of Silverton, Colorado for crib wall repair. *No OS/OW allowed on US Hwy 550 Molas Pass. Motorists will encounter Alternating/Southbound and Northbound single lane traffic controlled by flaggers or portable traffic signals from mile post 68 to mile post 69. Within the project area, one travel lane will be closed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and traffic will be diverted onto the other lane. Work hour delays (7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday-Saturday) will generally be no more than 20 minutes. Non-work hour delays are approximately 5 minutes.*

CO 145 Northbound/Southbound San Miguel County (Milemarker 75.71-78.5) (through July 2017)

7:00 AM-7:00 PM TU-TH Southbound lanes closed. Traffic shifted to northbound lanes with traffic signals/ alternating north and south bound traffic. MP 77 to MP 78.5; Occasional holds to allow truck traffic to enter and leave work zone.

Estimated wait time 5 to 15 minutes; Work includes Detour Removals / Cleanup MP 78.5. Excavation/Removals MP 76.

CO 62 Eastbound/Westbound Ridgeway St. (Milemarker 22.8-23.23) (through June 2017)

24 Hours- SA Clinton Street Closed between Cora & Laura (Alternate Routes will be available). *All traffic on SH 62 is now running on the new road. Westbound traffic will be forced left at the end of the bridge onto the new alignment. 7:00 AM-6:00 PM TU-FR Alternating one lane traffic from Uncompahgre River Bridge West to Laura Street for sub-excavation & hand rail installation (Sections at a time) Alternating one lane traffic from Laura Street West to Amelia Street for Road Widening (Sections at a time) Clinton Street Closed between Cora & Laura Limited parking on Charles & Lena Street; Trucks entering highway, road widening, sidewalk demo, grading, handrail, crosswalk installation, irrigation, planting & mulching. *All traffic on SH 62 is now running on the new road. Westbound traffic will be forced left at the end of the bridge onto the new alignment. 24 Hours- SU-MO Intersection of Laura Street & Clinton Street, North & West Crosswalks (Alternate Routes Available). *All traffic on SH 62 is now running on the new road. CO 90 Northbound/Southbound west of Bedrock Store, Bedrock (Milemarker 15.06-16.2) (through August 2017)

24 Hours- SU-SA Single-lane, alternating travel at 1 mile section of SH90 east of Bedrock Bridge for bridge removal; expect approximately 2-minute delay (temp. signal in use). *Intermittent construction equipment may cross the one lane bridge. Speed limit over the bridge is 25 mph. Signs posted regarding OS/OW restrictions and have been in place since 12/2013.*
