## PUBLIC MEETING #1 OVERVIEW

A transportation study of US 24 between Powers Boulevard (SH 21) and the Town of Ramah is underway. The Colorado Department of Transportation is conducting this Planning and Environmental Linkages (PEL) study to examine improvements for this important corridor. The study will provide a more thorough understanding of the existing and future transportation conditions along US 24 and identify socioeconomic, environmental, and resource concerns and opportunities in the corridor and screen a range of improvements to develop an implementation plan for future projects to meet the operational, safety, and capacity needs of the corridor.
