

US 24 DRAFT STUDY RECOMMENDATIONS AVAILABLE FOR COMMENT

A transportation study of US 24 between Powers Boulevard (CO 21) and the Town of Ramah is nearly complete. The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) is conducting this Planning and Environmental Linkages (PEL) study to identify projects that improve regional and local mobility, improve intersection operations, and enhance safety for all corridor users.

Transportation improvement alternatives were developed and screened using local agency and public stakeholder input. Draft study recommendations and evaluation of these improvements will be presented at the study's final public meeting on September 28th. Input from the public meeting will be used to refine the study recommendations before they are finalized.

The existing Access Control Plan (ACP) along US 24 between Peterson Boulevard and Elbert Road will be updated with minor modifications to reflect the study recommendations for roadway and intersection configurations. No changes are proposed to the number or types of accesses shown in the ACP.

- Complete NEPA analyses for projects
- Complete design of individual projects
- Obtain right-of-way, if needed
- Complete construction of individual projects
