
Phase 1 Resurfacing of US 287 to begin in June US 287 from Carpenter Road to Harmony Road

Project Overview

The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) has announced a project to resurface a three-mile segment of US 287 in Fort Collins from just north of Carpenter Road/State Highway (SH) 392 to approximately 500 feet south of the intersection of Harmony Road.

The project will increase safety and mobility for motorists on this busy section of highway by improving the roadway surface, including upgraded pedestrian ramps. When completed, the project will create a safer trip through the corridor for motorists, as well as update ADA standards for bicyclists and pedestrians.

Coulson Excavating of Loveland was awarded the \$2.7 million contract by CDOT.



Project Time Line

Crews will begin concrete and guardrail repairs the second week of June and should not impact the travelling public. Asphalt removal and paving operations are scheduled to begin in the latter half of June. The project is scheduled for completion in September 2014.

Traffic Impacts

Normal work hours will be Monday through Friday from 5 a.m. to 3 p.m. for the milling and paving operations. Motorists can expect single lane closures and delays of less than 15 minutes. Motorists can expect reduced speeds throughout the three-mile stretch. No night or weekend work is currently scheduled. Work is weather permitting.
