Detour from US Highway 50 to Paul Harvey

Crews working on the US Highway 50 resurfacing project from Bonforte Boulevard in Pueblo to Avondale Boulevard will put in a signed detour starting Monday night. Traffic will be detoured from US 50 to Paul Harvey Blvd then onto William White Blvd and Pete Jimenez Parkway. The detour will be in place on Tuesday night as well. It is possible the detour will be in effect for more nights.

CDOT, in conjunction with Martin Marietta, will have the detour in place because the roadway under the bridge is too narrow for traffic to get through with milling and paving operations. The detour will help eliminate a safety hazard that could take place where the bridge narrows.

Traffic Impacts

August 8 and 9, motorists will encounter a detour from US 50 to Paul Harvey Blvd.

Beginning July 31, motorists encounter night work on US 50 from Bonforte Blvd to Avondale Blvd.

Traffic impacts include:

- Detour will take place from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday and Tuesday nights. With the possibility of it being in place next week as well.
- Various lane and shoulder closures take place within the work zone with speeds reduced to 45 mph.
- Traffic fines will be doubled in the work zone.
- Motorists should slow down as they approach the work zones, drive with caution, allow extra space between vehicles and give themselves extra travel time.
