### CDOT'S U.S. 50 CORRIDOR EAST WEB SITE INCLUDES CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION

**PUEBLO, Colo. (September 26, 2005)** – The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) recently set up a Web site for the U.S. 50 Corridor East project, [www.us50east.com](http://www.us50east.com). A new feature added to the Web site is a *Construction Information* section, whereby citizens can obtain information on improvements occurring on and near the U.S. 50 Corridor from Pueblo to the vicinity of the Kansas State Line.
