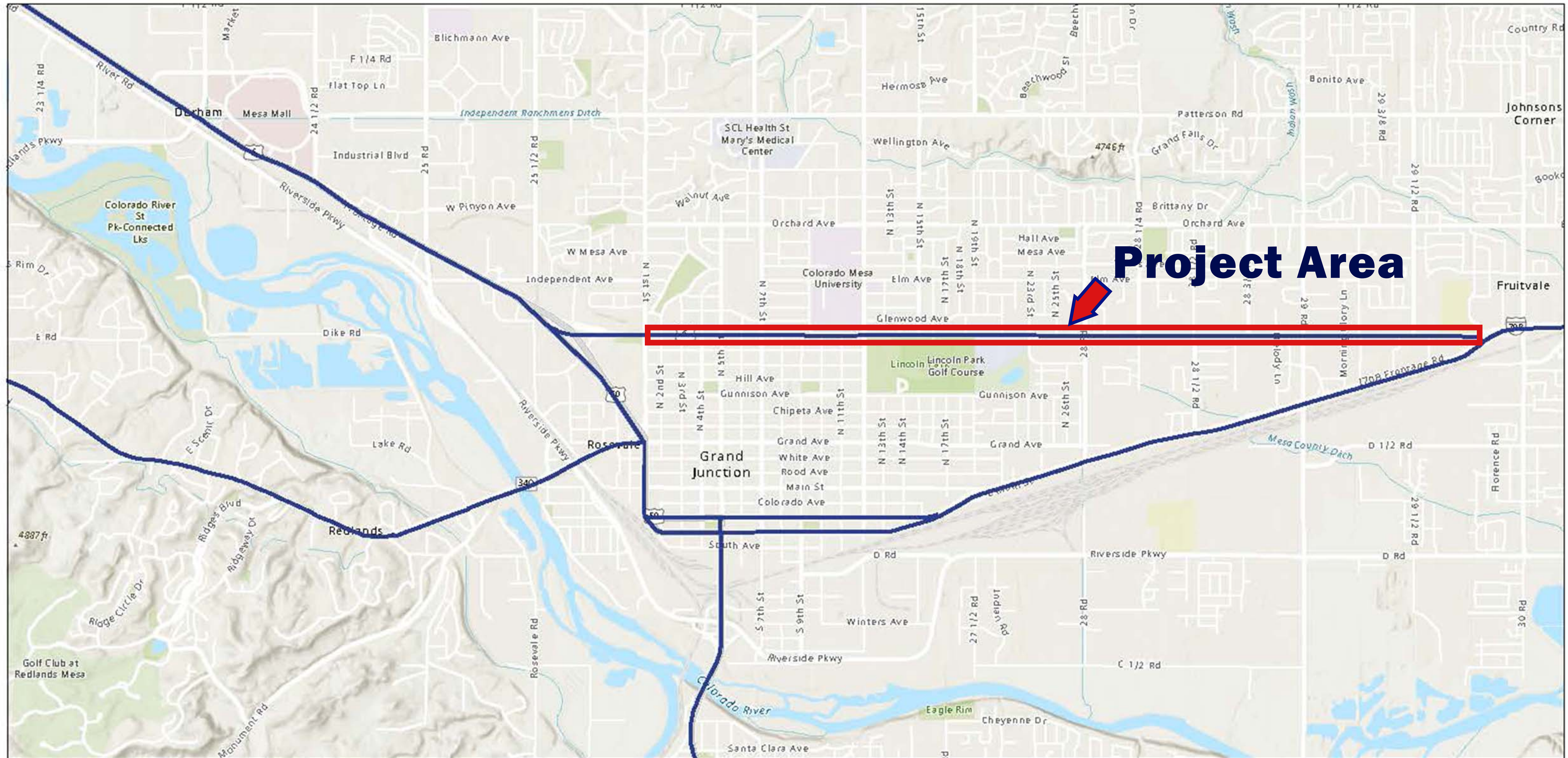

The project area includes US 6 (North Ave) from 1st Street to I-70B

Project Information

The scope, schedule, and traffic impacts associated with the project are shown below.

Scope of work

- Resurface road with 2 inches of asphalt pavement
- Replace and install new medians to control access, improve safety, and improve traffic flow

Schedule

- Start of Construction: End of March/Beginning of April 2022
- End of Construction - End of October/Beginning of November 2022

Traffic Impacts

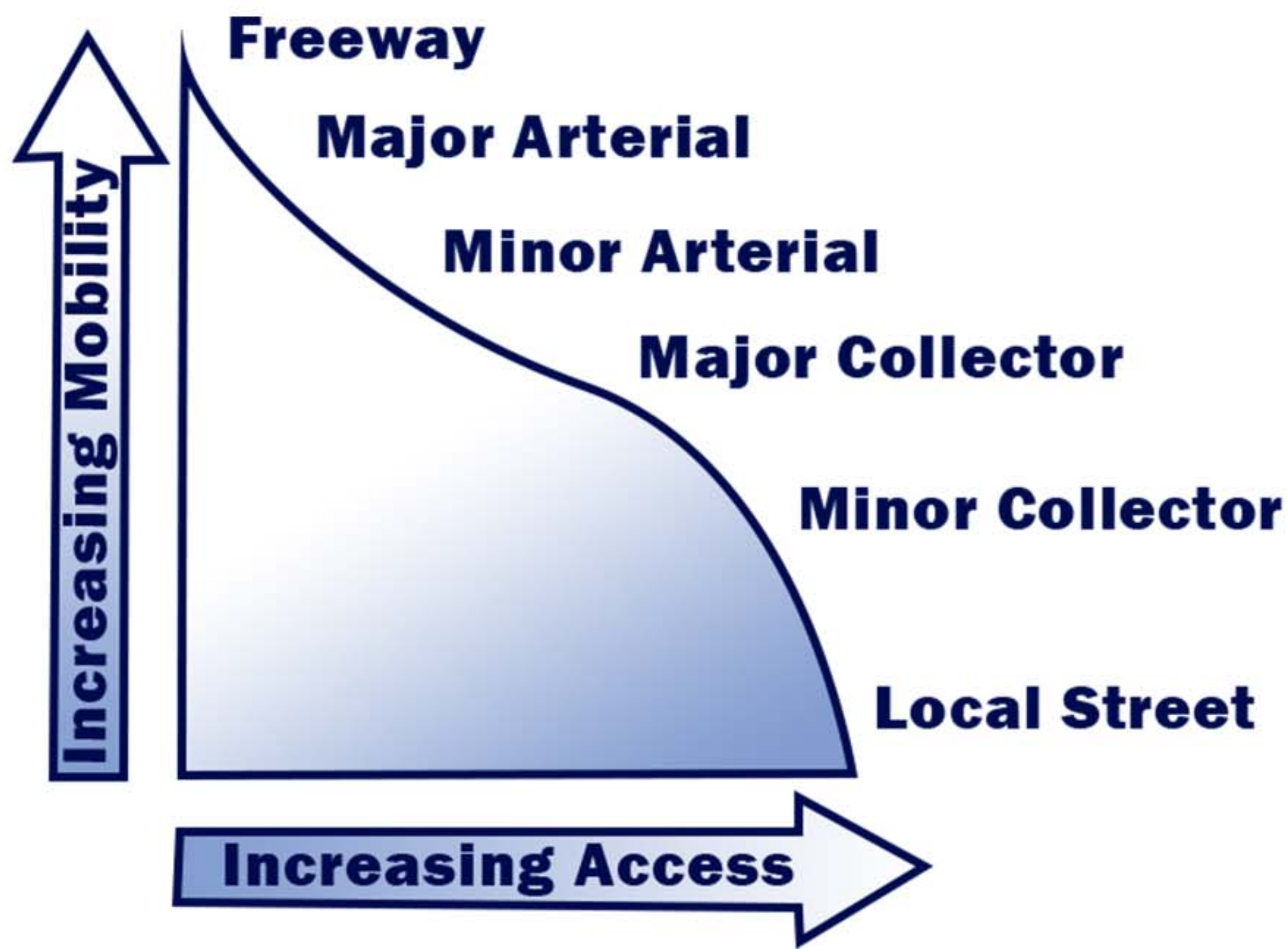
- Work will be done at night
- North Ave will be reduced down to one lane in each direction
 - Business access will be maintained



ACCESS CONTROL BENEFITS

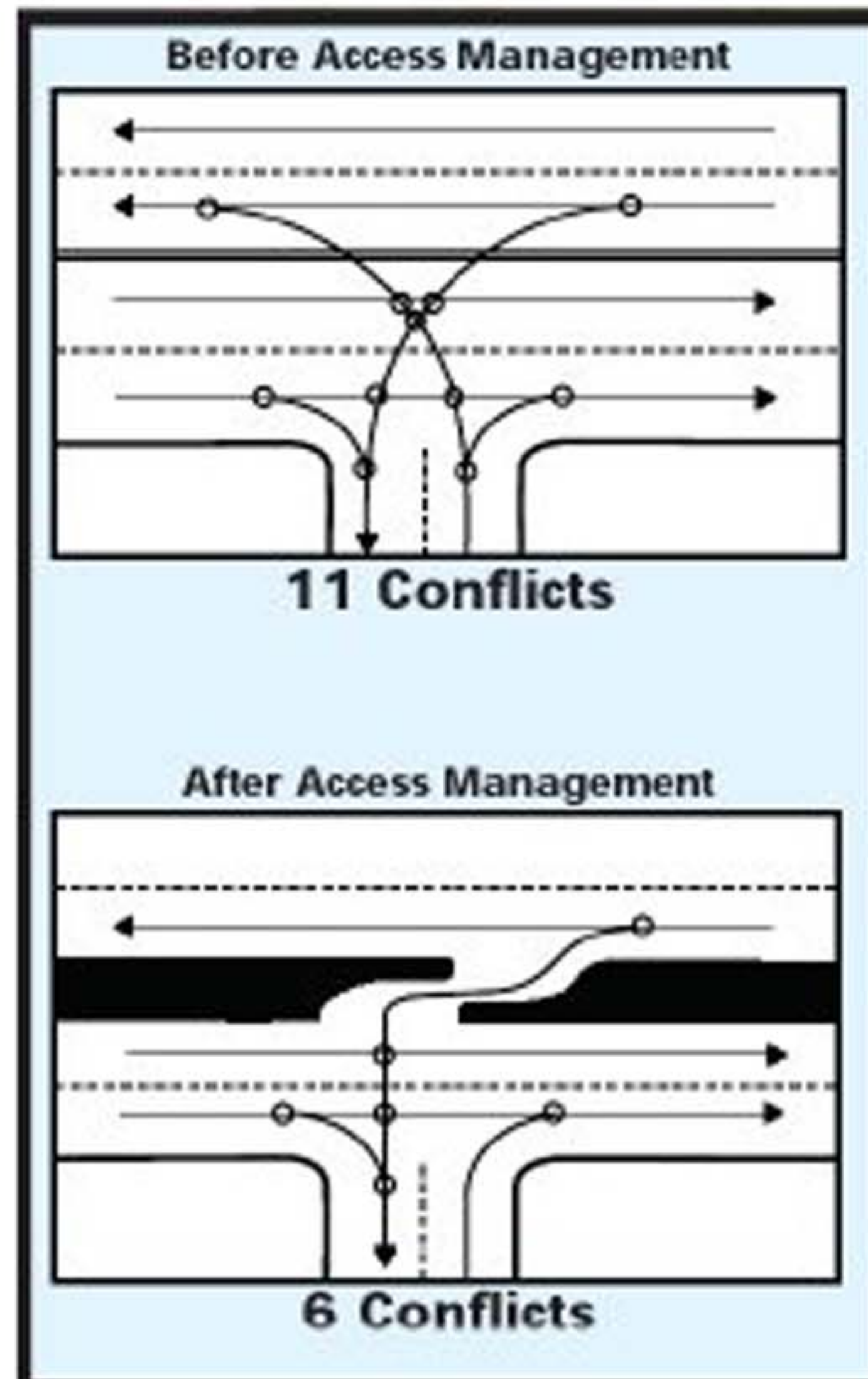
Access control improves traffic flow, improves safety, and is good for business

Improves Traffic Flow



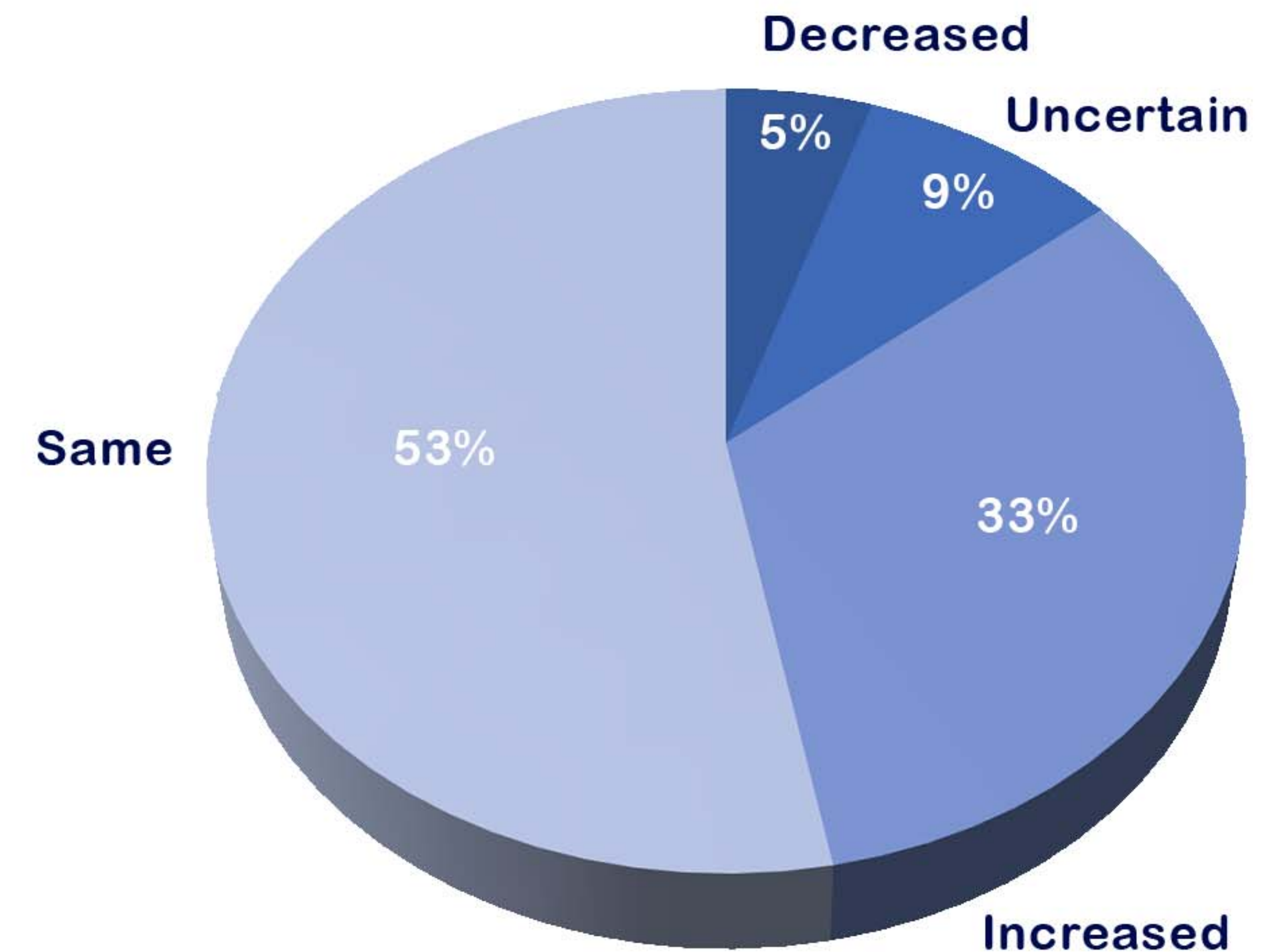
Reducing access on a Minor Arterial like North Ave increases the capacity of the roadway and shortens travel Time for motorists.

Good For Business

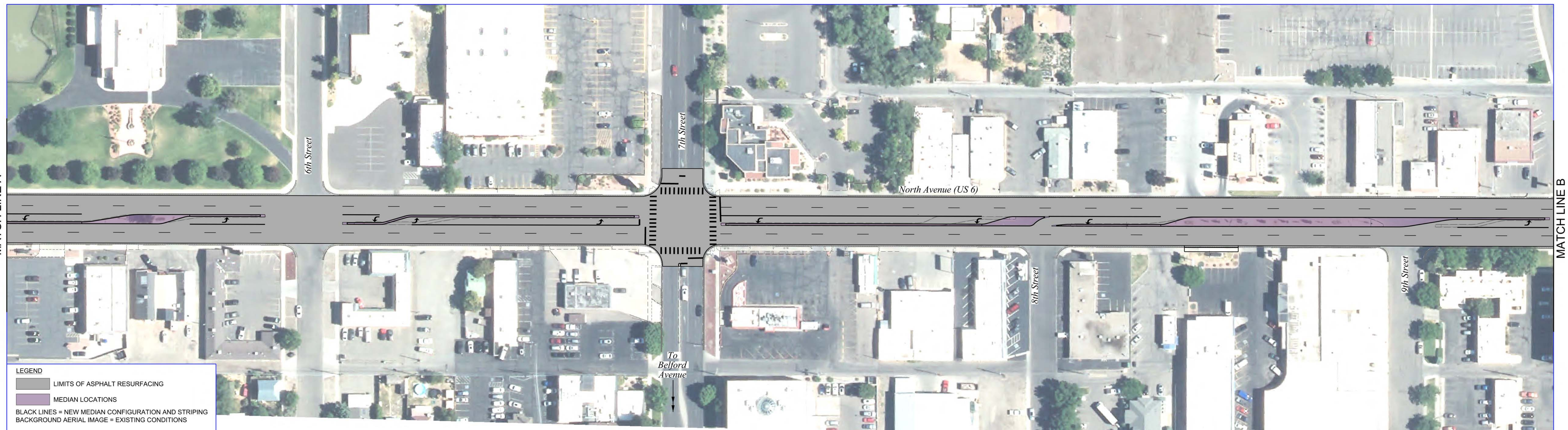
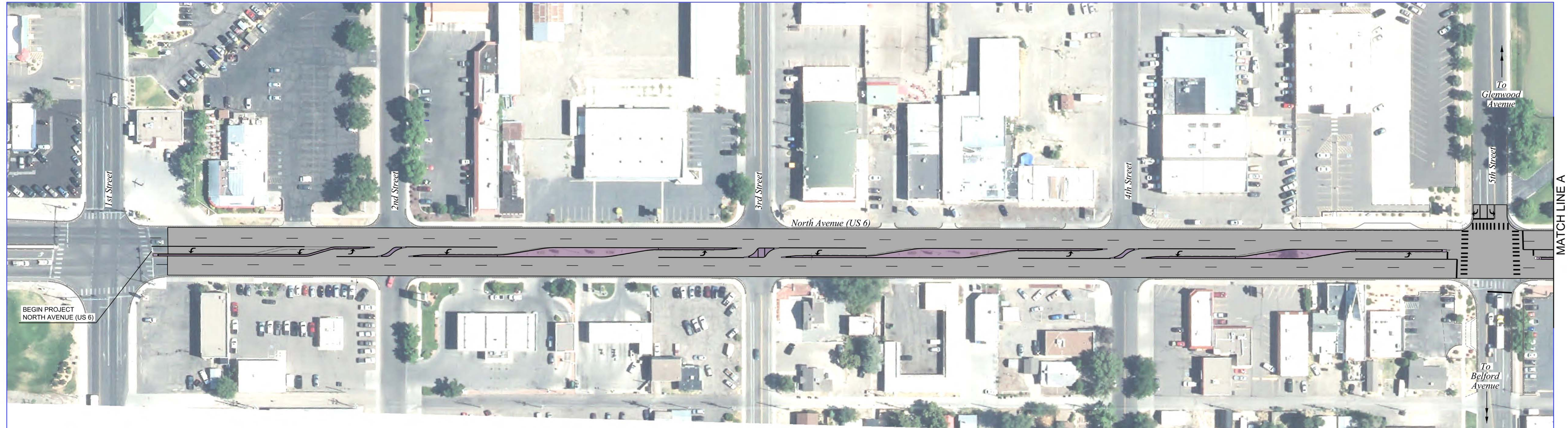


Impact on Business Sales After Access Management Project

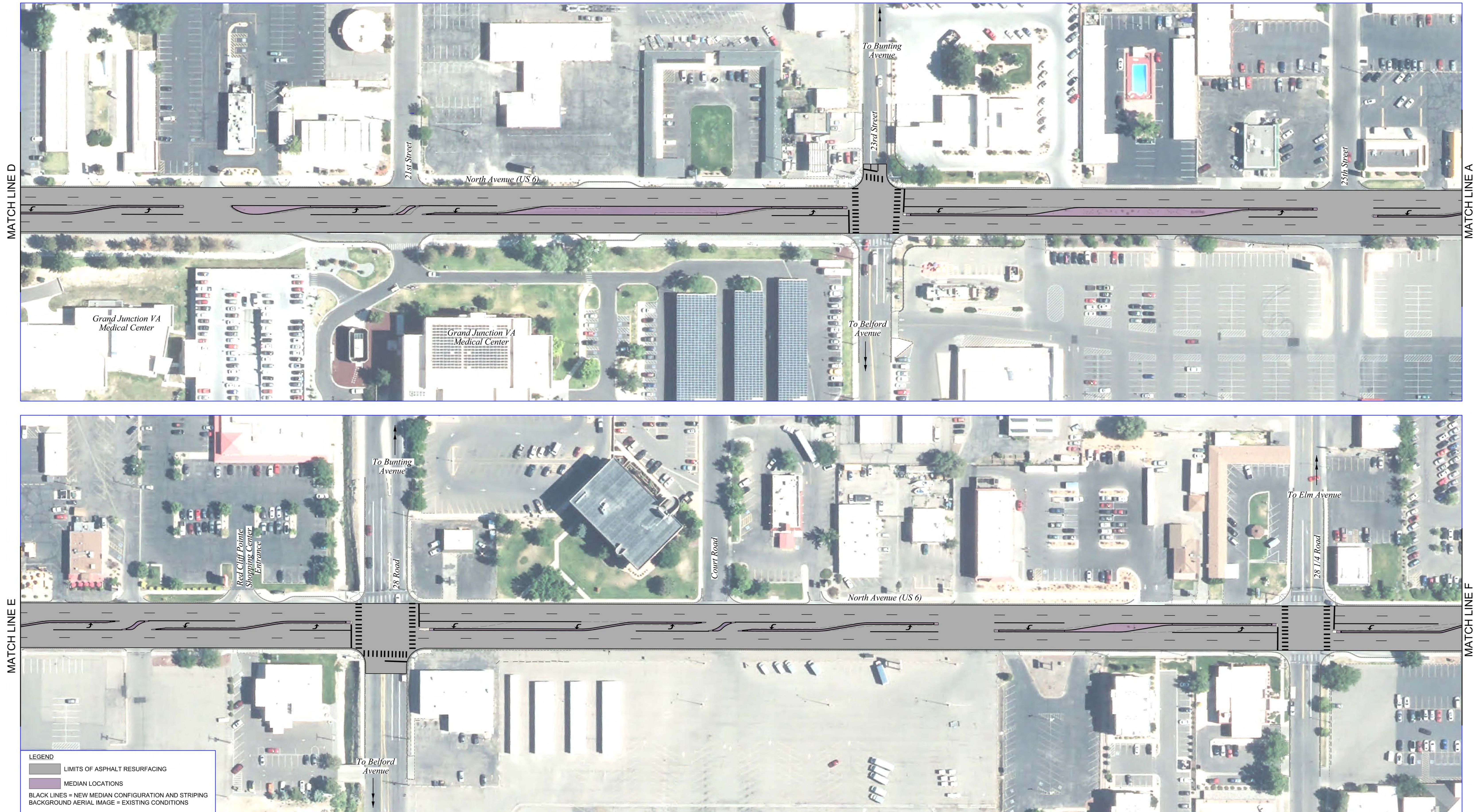
