

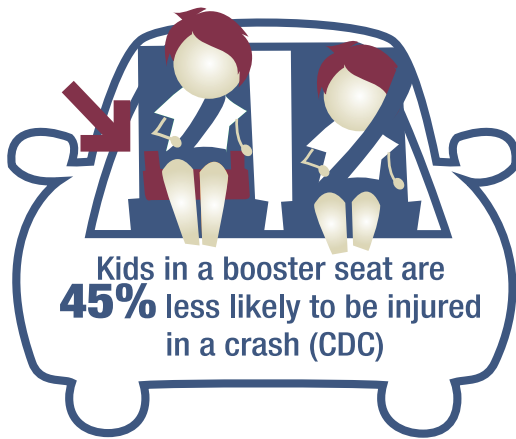

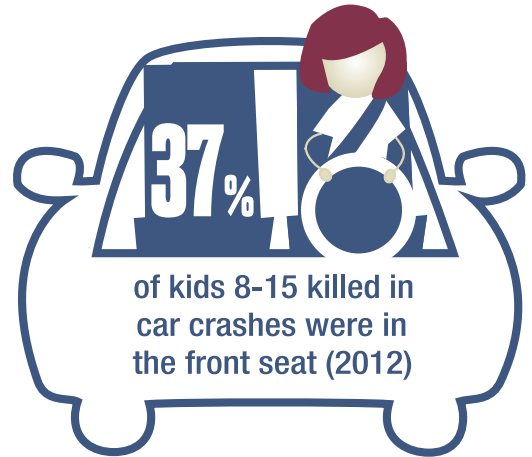
CONSEQUENCES



2,474 children were injured and **8** were killed in motor vehicle crashes in 2012

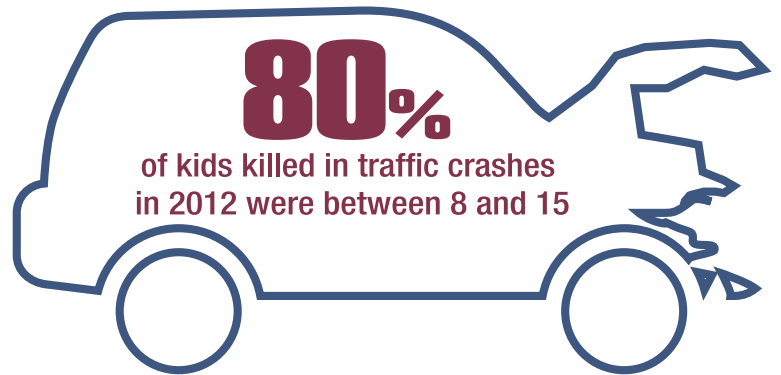
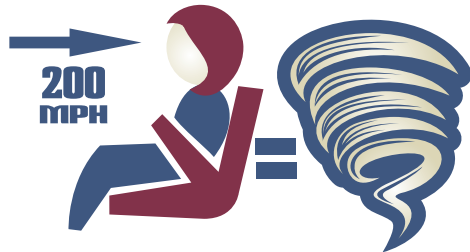


Kids in a booster seat are **45%** less likely to be injured in a crash (CDC)



37% of kids 8-15 killed in car crashes were in the front seat (2012)

Airbags move at a similar speed to a **devastating tornado**



80% of kids killed in traffic crashes in 2012 were between 8 and 15



A car moving as slowly as **16 MPH** can deploy airbags in a collision (IIHS)
