RECERTIFICATION

Start early! Here are 2 FREE and easy ways to earn your CEU's:

- Attend an in-person training. Included in this newsletter is a complete
 list of upcoming training. At these classes, a CPS Instructor will also be
 available to observe and verify the 5 required seat checks.
- Earn them online! Safe Kids has prepared a tip sheet for earning CEU's online, see attached.

The re-certification audit rate is about 30% - so don't think it can't happen to you -be prepared!

Speaking of audit, Sallie Thoreson of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment in Grand Junction shares her recent audit experience:

"I've been audited! GULP!!

It's not quite like being contacted by the IRS, but it still caused some anxiety when I got the e-mail from: CPS Auditor [cpsaudit@safekids.org] with the subject line: CPS CEU Audit. GULP! I did remember Susan Yates told us at my Refresher training that Safe Kids audits about 30% of the CPST recertifications. So I wasn't too worried, and it turned out to be a relatively painless process. The email provides you with good instructions on how to print out your reported activities and what to submit. They answered my e-mail question promptly and gave me 30 days to submit the materials. The main take-home message is to keep track of your paperwork! I had to provide written proof of attendance and content for all CEUs I submitted. I had my certificates with CEU Event ID from my Refresher class (thanks Susan!) and my other 2 CEU classes. I also submitted copies of my completed Tech Update guizzes and the first pages of the journal articles I read. You can check your audit status on your profile page, but just to be sure I e-mailed them and I got the good news "your audit is complete." Not quite as good as winning the lottery, but satisfying to know I'm part of the elite group, with all of you, that makes a difference in the lives of children. "

TECHNICIAN PROXY PROGRAM

Recently Safe Kids unveiled a new "Technician Proxy" program. We are really excited over this new program and believe it will help make the recertification process easier for many; specifically those who live in areas without a CPS Instructor nearby.

- Technician Proxies can review and approve seat checks for recertification. This is not associated in any way with being a Senior Checker. It is simply a way to fill a need in areas with few Certified Instructors. Once approved as a Technician Proxy, you will remain one until your CPS Certification expires.
- Anyone who has been a Certified Technician for at least six months, or is an Instructor Candidate, may apply to be a Technician Proxy. When you are eligible to apply, you will see the action item "Apply to be A Technician Proxy" in your CPS Online Profile.
- Once approved, your status will continue to be "Certified Technician" but you will see Extra Training: Technician Proxy in your Online Profile.
