

The number of young drivers involved in fatal crashes has fallen by almost 50% in the last 20 years.

But recently more young drivers have been involved in fatal crashes.

2005 - 2016: Colorado averaged **64** young drivers involved in fatal crashes per year.

2017 - 2019: Colorado averaged 82 young drivers involved in fatal crashes per year, an increase of 28%.

Drivers 20 and younger involved in fatal crashes


