2. SEAT BELTS I will always wear a seat belt. All of my passengers will wear seat belts, as required by law.	☐ Lose driving privileges for wks/mos
3. CURFEWS I will not drive after p.m. at night. I understand that it is against state law to drive between midnight and 5 a.m. for the first year with my license. Check local curfew, which may vary from state laws.	☐ Lose driving privileges for wks/mos
4. CHECK IN I will check in with my parent(s) or guardian(s) every time I drive and let them know where I am going, who I am going with and when I will return.	☐ Lose driving privileges for wks/mos
5. ALCOHOL AND DRUGS I will never use alcohol or drugs when I am driving and never ride with someone who has used them. Colorado has a ZERO TOLERANCE law for minor drivers.	☐ Lose driving privileges for wks/mos
