Colorado's BAC Limits

Colorado has DUI and DWAI limits for driving. However, if your ability to drive is impaired to the slightest degree, you can still be arrested for drunk driving.

Driving While Ability Impaired

DWAI .05% - .08%

Driving Under the Influence


DUI .08% or Higher

Consequences

- Arrest and jail time.
 Loss of driving privileges.
- ► Fines on average, a DUI costs more than \$13,500.
- Upon arrest for a DUI, if a driver refuses a breath or blood test, they may be subject to additional consequences.

Breathalyzers

Breathalyzers provide a more accurate BAC reading by measuring the amount of alcohol found in an individual's breath. Smartphone breathalyzers are now a widely available and affordable tool, providing real-time BAC information to help you make informed decisions whenever you are out drinking.



Plan Ahead

- Plan a sober ride home before you start drinking.
- Pace yourself eat food and drink plenty of water.
- A DUI charge stays on your criminal record forever — don't be afraid to take someone's keys.
