**SUBJECT:** **S-614-4, “Class III Signs”**

With this memorandum, the Safety and Traffic Engineering Branch is issuing revisions to the S-614-4 Standard Plans.

The following is the revision on the S-614-4 Standard Plan set:

- Sheet 2/3 -

Two new details are included on this sheet: “Typical Bottom Plaque Installation for Ground signs (Full Width Plaque Support)” and “Typical Bottom Plaque Installation for Ground signs (Partial Width Plaque Support)”. The purpose of these two details is to illustrate where the fuse and splice plate locations are in reference to the backing zee of the plaques.

The Revised Standard Plan S-614-4, Sheet 2, supersedes the current Standard Plans sheet of the same title and sheet number.

The designer should be sure that there are no other plan requirements or special provisions that conflict with these standards.
