**Subject:** Revisions of Standard Plan S-612-1 Delineator Installations

With this memorandum, the Traffic Safety and Engineering Services Branch is issuing revisions to the S-612-1 standard plan set.

The Revised Standard Plan S-612-1 Sheets 1,2,3, and 6 of 8 supersedes all previous standard plans of the same title and sheet number.

The following revisions have been made to the S-612-1 standard plan set:

### Global Changes:

- ADA Readability Formatting

### Sheet 1 of 8

- Fixed punctuation of “Typical 1.12# Delineator Post”

### Sheet 2 of 8

- Revised Median Crossover Delineators symbols and referred to Sheet 8
- Labeled Type III (Green,Blue) as Maintenance Markers
- Revised Bridge Approach Notes and Delineator Symbols
- Fixed direction of travel arrow on Typical Installation for Lane Transition

### Sheet 3 of 8

- Labeled Bridge Joint Markers (OM1-U)/(OM1-D)
- Labeled Type III (Green) as Maintenance Markers

### Sheet 6 of 8:

- Labeled Bridge Joint Markers (OM1-U)/(OM1-D) under Supplemental Delineation Details

The designer should ensure that there are no other plan requirements or special provisions that conflicts with this standard.
