Subject: Revisions of Standard Plans S-614-01 "Ground Sign Placement"

With this memorandum, the Traffic Safety and Engineering Branch issuing the S-614-01 standard plan set. This standard plan set, with all revisions, supersedes all previous standard plans of the same title.

The following revisions have been made to the S-614-01 standard plan set:

Sheet 1 of 2

- Revised general note 4 and 8 to reference the latest version of the MUTCD.
- Added Note 16.
 - "THE MOUNTING HEIGHT OF CROSSBUCK SIGNS, MEASURED VERTICALLY FROM THE CENTER BOTTOM OF THE SIGN TO THE ELEVATION OF THE NEAR EDGE OF THE PAVEMENT, SHOULD BE APPROXIMATELY 7 FEET, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THE COLORADO SUPPLEMENT TO SECTION 8B.03 OF THE MUTCD."

The designer should ensure that there are no other plan requirements or special provisions that conflicts with this standard.
