Re: Orchard Road Resurfacing City of Greenwood Village's 2012 Rejuvenator Seal Project

This is notification that a seal coat is scheduled to be placed on Orchard Road between Jackson St. and Holly St. on Saturday, July 21st from the hours of 9 am to 6 pm. In order to reduce the traffic delays and produce a safe work zone, Orchard Road will be open to EAST BOUND TRAVEL ONLY from Jackson St. to Holly St. (see attached map).

The map denotes the detour routes that will allow access to all intersecting streets during the work period. Access to these intersecting streets may be restricted for a 10 minute period while the product cures and sand is placed to prevent tracking.

The treatment is called a rejuvenator seal and is designed to rejuvenate the surface of the asphalt and retard future cracking caused by aging and oxidation. A sand layer will be placed on the surface to reduce tracking of the material. This sand will be swept up within 48 hours. Any material tracked onto concrete driveways will naturally weather off in 2-3 weeks.
