**Re: S. Yosemite St. Paving – E. Peakview Ave. to E Caley Ave.
City of Greenwood Village 2013 Pavement Rehabilitation Project**

This notification is to inform you that final paving of S. Yosemite St. from E. Peakview Ave. to E. Caley Ave. is scheduled for **Saturday, October 5th and Sunday, October 6th**. These improvements are part of the Greenwood Village 2013 Pavement Rehabilitation Project.

To expedite the resurfacing, S. Yosemite St. from E. Peakview Ave. to E. Caley Ave. will be closed starting at 4:00 a.m. on Saturday, October 5th, and will re-open no later than 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 6th. The map on the reverse side of this notice shows the closure area, and the posted detour routes.

In case of emergency, police and fire vehicles will be allowed through at all times. During the paving operations, we ask that you observe and obey all traffic control measures to ensure a safe work zone and to expedite the construction work.


RTD has been notified of the closure, and will modify bus routes accordingly during the closure hours.
