


Featured Byways!

Length: 116 miles. Driving time: 3 hours




- Mesa Verde National Park

The Anasazi - the "Ancient Ones" to the later Navajo - guarded their secrets closely. This 116-mile route across the broken, arid terrain of their former civilization is heavily laden with clues: cliff dwellings, rock art, pottery shards.
