Length: 131 miles. Driving time: 5 hours.



Royal Gorge Bridge Mueller State Park Florissant Fossil Beds National Monument Garden Park Dinosaur Fossil Area



This 131-mile circuit tours historic Cripple Creek, Florence, McCourt, Adelaide, Wilbur, Victor, and other former gold camps. Majestic Pikes Peak, the unspoiled Beaver Creek Wilderness Study Area, spectacular Royal Gorge, and miles of high-country beauty.

Length: 115 miles. Driving time: 3 hours.





Arkansas Headwaters State Recreation Area Arkansas River Headwaters State Park National Mining Hall of Fame and Museum Healy House Museum White River National Forest



This 82-mile route crosses the Continental Divide twice and traces the Arkansas River nearly to its source in the vicinity of Fremont Pass. The small communities of Redcliff, Minturn, and Twin Lakes add charm.
