Pawnee Pioneer Trails

Length: 128 miles. Driving time: 3 hours

Creede and Lake City remain strewn with abandoned mining structures. Between the two towns, Highway 149 shadows the upper reaches of the Rio Grande, serving up a bounty of natural wonders - sparkling North Clear Creek Falls, the Slumgullion earth slide, and the shark-like fin of Uncompahgre Peak.
